

Lectra announces the immediate reopening of its Bordeaux-Cestas site

- **Reopening of the Bordeaux-Cestas site following the improvement in the wildfire situation in Gironde region and the easing of precautionary measures decided by the authorities.**
- **No damage has been identified at the Group's facilities.**
- **Immediate resumption of operations under normal operating conditions.**

Paris, July 30, 2026 – **Following the favorable evolution of the wildfire situation in Gironde region and the gradual lifting of the restrictions announced today by the authorities, Lectra has resumed operations at its Bordeaux-Cestas site, which had been temporarily closed since July 27, 2026. No damage has been identified at the Group's facilities, and operations are resuming under normal operating conditions.**

Given the short duration of the closure (three days) and the measures implemented by Lectra's teams, the impact on the Group's operations is expected to be negligible. Located outside the area directly affected by wildfires, the Bordeaux-Cestas site sustained no damage, enabling operations to resume under normal conditions.

The Group's management and local teams remained fully mobilized throughout the period to support employees affected by the evacuation measures and to ensure continuous monitoring of the situation. Most of them will be able to return to their home as early as today.

The Group is grateful for the commitment of its employees and partners, whose responsiveness made it possible to adapt working arrangements and maintain continuity for essential operations and customer support during the site closure.

Lectra would like to extend its heartfelt thanks to them, as well as to the firefighters and emergency services involved on the ground, the regional authorities, the municipality of Cestas, the Group's customers for their understanding, and everyone who expressed their support over the past few days.
