

Lectra announces the temporary closure of its Bordeaux-Cestas site

- **Temporary closure of the Bordeaux-Cestas site following the preventive evacuation measures decided by the authorities.**
- **People safety is Lectra's top priority.**
- **As the site is not located directly in the area affected by the fire, no damage to the facilities has been noted at this stage.**

Paris, July 27, 2026 – **As part of the preventive evacuation measures decided by the Gironde authorities in response to the ongoing fires in southwestern France, Lectra announces the temporary closure of its Bordeaux-Cestas site. While the site is not located in the area directly affected by the fire, it is subject to safety measures. As soon as the authorities issued the alert during the night of July 25, 2026, the Group activated its internal emergency plan to ensure people safety, protect its facilities and implement the necessary measures in response to the situation.**

Priority to people safety

The Cestas site has about eight hundred employees, in addition to employees from subcontracting companies. About two hundred of them have been evacuated from their homes. The safety of everyone is Lectra's top priority. The Group's management and local teams are fully committed to supporting the employees affected by the evacuation measures as well as their families.

Situation report

The site is currently closed until further notice, in accordance with the authorities' instructions. As of today, based on the information currently available, no damage has been reported at the facilities. At this stage, however, it remains difficult to estimate when the site will reopen or to assess any potential impact at the Group level. A dedicated task force is continuously monitoring the situation, in close coordination with the relevant authorities.
